#### SMART TUITION:

You may have noticed that your September 15th payment was not taken from your designated bank account or credit card. Due to some medical issues with our Business Manager, several of our parents accounts have not been set up yet. If your payment was not withdrawn, you have a choice to make:

Included in the price is admission and cider and donuts. Everyone must bring a bagged lunch, food is NOT available for sale. This is an outdoor fieldtrip and students must dress accordingly. Bestmaze Corn Maze is located at 3803 Noble Road, Williamston, Michigan 48895. Permission slips and payment are due no later than Thursday, October 10th. Late permission slips cannot be accepted. We will not be able to change our counts or add people to our



group rate after Thursday, October 10th. Thank you for your understanding. If you are driving, please be sure to return an Auto Verification Form. Ask your teacher to give you one.

**FOR THE SAFETY OF YOUR CHILD**: Please send in a signed note if your child is planning on leaving the building with someone other than a parent or "pick-up person" designated on their emergency card. We would like a note from the parent releasing their child and the parent picking the child up. We cannot allow students to leave school with friends unless we have something in writing. Thank you for your cooperation.

<u>SCHOOL DROP OFF AND TARDIES</u>: Please remember that if your are dropping off your child in the morning or picking them up in the evening that you should use doors 2 or 3. Grades 3-8 will be at door #2 and preschool –2nd grade and their siblings at door #3. If you are tardy, please come to door #1 and stop by the office for your tardy slip. Parents entering the school should park in the lot by the school offices on Main Street and enter through door #1.

**FAST DIRECT-** Grades 3-8: Are you checking on your child's grades? Fast Direct is a modern day progress report. Through Fast Direct, you see your child's grades on individual assignments, you see a cumulative grade, and you see if there are any missing assignments. The problem is that we know that many parents are not using this tool because Fast Direct also tells us, who is using the system. So - **PLEASE** - check your child's progress. Report card grades should **NEVER** be a surprise. Use the codes given to you and check on your child's progress weekly. Any questions - Contact your teacher.
