That being said, we regret to inform you that we have received an email from one of our teachers, Mrs. Mullins, who has informed us that she has tested positive for Covid-19 this morning. She has not been feeling well so she got tested. She has been out of school since last Friday at the end of the day.

Mrs. Mullins is one of our teachers who teaches multiple ages and subjects. Through our discussion with Mrs. Mullins, we have determined that she was teaching all students in grades 1-8 last Friday. We are immediately enacting our Board of Education's policy and switching to an online format for Grades 1-8 beginning tomorrow. Preschool and Kindergarten will continue to meet in person since those students had no contact with Mrs. Mullins. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause you.

Our plan is to conduct a regular school day online for grades 1-8 tomorrow. Obviously, there will be no specials (music, PE, Spanish for elementary, and art). Teachers will provide instructions for students and send home textbooks and supplies today. We are creating plans right now so we will communicate more details once we have them. If you prefer to come and take your child home now that is fine, otherwise, we will complete the school day today.

Unfortunately, the Christmas Service at St. Paul Lutheran Church led by the students this evening and next week will be canceled. A midweek Advent service provided by Pastor Andrzejewski will still take place in-house. We are sorry for the inconvenience and disruption this causes you.

As always, our trust is in the Lord. Please join us as we pray for Mrs. Mullin's quick recovery and protection for our St. Paul family. May God bless your Christmas season. Please feel free to call me if you have questions.
