FINANCIAL AID FOR 2020-2021: St. Paul provides grants for tuition assistance for families that qualify for financial aid. We have enlisted the services of Smart Aid, a company that provides a financial aid analysis service, for the purpose of evaluating an applicant's need for aid. If you feel you may qualify for aid, you must complete an online application at: smartaidforparents.com. The application fee is \$35, and our School ID is 13489. Your application will only be considered if your tuition is current. **Completed Applications and Supporting Documents are due by April 30, 2020. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
