FROM THE BOARD OF ED: First semester is officially over. The third and fourth quarters loom ahead. Lutheran Schools Week & Open House, the celebration of Easter, and the end of the year activities are some of the events to look forward to. Our hope and prayer is that all of the students and families will finish out this year strong in God's strength and peace (Psalm 29:11). We are also praying that each student will put forth their best effort to achieve in their academics according to their abilities and to focus fully each day that they are in class, either in-person or virtually. To assist in closing the gap of the \$9,000 educational cost per student, the Board of Education has approved a very modest tuition increase for the well-rounded curriculum that each child at St. Paul Lutheran School receives. For the next school year of 2021-2022, tuition is an additional \$300.00 per student. The fees sheet will be sent out soon. Registration fees remain the same. A discount is applied for early registration as well as tuition payment in full at the beginning of the school year.
