Lutheran Schools' Week 2021 **March 1 - 7**

Next week we will be celebrating Lutheran Schools' Week. We celebrate with special opportunities for learning and fun. This year our focus will be on Literature.

Our Theme: Life's An Adventure

Each day we will have a different theme. Children are encouraged to wear clothes that go along with the different type of adventure you might read. Children will be given time to read during school each day, and we're asking them to bring something with them to make that time more comfy/fun. We'll start each day with all school devotions and enjoy a special snack each afternoon. Each child in grades K-8 will have a secret pal for the week. Boys will be matched with a boy pal, and girls with girls. **We are asking you to send in a small treat to share with your pal each day.**

Tuesday - An eraser

Wednesday - Something to color with

Thursday - A little tablet

Friday - A sweet treat (nothing peanut, please)



We will be assembling travel kits to share with the homeless. **We are asking children in each grade to bring in an item for these kits.**

The children will sing in church on Sunday, March 7 at the 11:00 a.m. service. Come and see Book Reports and displays from the week.


