Mission Aspect

First Gifts "Missions"

The goal of the **Our House – His Throne** campaign is to raise funds to address projects that we have been aware of but not able to fund through our normal operating budgets.

As with our personal budgets and sacrificial gifts to the church, giving should come before considering other expenses – "First Fruits" application.

Therefore, the first 10% of contributions to the Our House - His Throne campaign will be dedicated to missions and programs that support the work of the church with the focus to reach beyond our walls.

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
CHURCH PROJECTS:

- 1. Correct and Repair High East Roof/Wall (Above Organ)
 - Includes roof membrane improvements, cap flashing configuration adjustments and replacement, repair of any insulation and decking that is deteriorated, assure proper drainage operation, clean wall efflorescence, and replace rusted basement emergency exit door and frame.

Budget: \$45,000


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

- 2. Repair weather damaged south wall / windows (At Nursery / Library-Meeting Room)
 - Secure, brace and reinforce the wall tipping and non-plum condition. Remove and replace rusted window & AC lintels. Install window flashing & dams. Simplify brick details for long term viability and cost savings. (Reuse existing windows and frames)
 - This work will include interior reconfiguration and finishes of the Women's and Men's
 Bathrooms including converting the Nursery Bathroom into a Family Handicapped
 Compliant Toilet Room
 Budget: \$160,000





3. Repair weather damaged south wall / windows (At offices)

4. Boiler Repairs / Replacement

 Monitor existing Boiler operations and develop maintenance/replacement strategy and timeline for required upgrades and/or replacement.
 Budget: \$100,000

2. All Classroom Finish Upgrades

Includes new cabinets, countertops, working sinks & facets, floor finishes, window blinds, and secure entry doors with appropriate latching hardware.
 Budget: \$150,000






