Simply type your phone number and check your name(s)! See an usher for assistance. **NOTE:** If your number does not work, please submit an attendance card with your updated information to the church office. **A minimum of 50% in-person attendance is required each quarter for church members to qualify for the member education rate. The Third quarter will end on March 24.**

**REENROLLMENT:** It's that time of year again - 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR REGISTRATION - REGISTRATION FEES are paid in the office and are not refundable. (Kindergarten - 8th Grade) (Per Child) Early Bird Discount Feb. 1 - Mar 31 is \$250; April - June 9 is \$350; June 10 or After is \$400. TECHNOLOGY FEE(K-8th Grade): \$100 per student. Preschool Registration Fee is \$150 per child Please send in your Smart Tuition Form with your registration. This form needs to be filled out every school year. Thank you.

We have enlisted the services of Smart Aid, a company that provides a financial aid analysis service, for the purpose of evaluating an applicant's need for aid. If you feel you may qualify for aid, you must complete an online application at: [smartaidforparents.com](http://smartaidforparents.com). The application fee is \$35, and our School ID is 13489. Your application will only be considered if your tuition is current. Completed Applications and Supporting Documents are due by April 30, 2023. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
