CHURCH ATTENDANCE: IN-PERSON CHURCH ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED FOR MEMBERS TO QUALIFY FOR THE MEMBER EDUCATION RATE. When you are attending church, we have two kiosks in the narthex to record your attendance! Simply type your phone number and check your name(s)! See an usher for assistance. NOTE: If your number does not work, please submit an attendance card with your updated information to the church office. A minimum of 50% in-person attendance is required each quarter for church members to qualify for the member education rate. The Fourth quarter will end on June 9.

**SMART TUITION**: If you haven't done so, please send in your re-enrollment form **ASAP** so we can set up your account for the 2023-2024 school year. Smart Tuition Forms need to be filled out every school year.

TIME AND TALENT HOURS: Each K-8th grade family is required to give 20 hours of service during the school year. You can earn these hours when you help in your child's classroom, drive for a field trip, attend a PTL meeting, or help at a PTL event. Upcoming volunteer opportunities are posted on the PTL board in the main hallway Please make sure you record your hours in the file box on the table outside the school office. A fee of \$10 per hour will be assessed if not served by May 31st.

ALL SCHOOL PICNIC: Our All School Picnic is on June 7 at Bloomer State Park in Rochester Hills. A permission slip was emailed home last week, and another is attached to the Viking today. Because this is a family event, we encourage you to drive your child(ren) and stay the day with us. Please remember that there will be no extended care after the picnic. If you have arranged a ride for your child, please pick them up at the school by 3:35 p.m. Permission slips are due by Friday, June 2, so we can have an accurate head count for food.

<u>PRESCHOOL GRADUATION</u> for 4 yr. old's will be held during the worship service at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, June 4. Please save the date and plan to worship with us, and congratulate them after the service, as they continue on to Kindergarten in the fall.

**REPORT CARD CHANGE**: In order to give teachers a reasonable amount of time to complete your child's fourth quarter report card, the final report card of the school year will be mailed to your house during the week of June 12.

**REENROLLMENT**: Registration for K-6th grade is now \$350. After June 10, it will go up to \$400. Preschool registration is \$150. If you are planning on returning to St. Paul in the fall, please send the form in today. We are already getting ready to order books etc. and need to know actual numbers. Sending in your reenrollment now will save you \$50, and also help us in preparation for a new school year. Thank you.
